NOTE: This regiment is not a successor of the 1<sup>st</sup> Maine Infantry, which was mustered out of service 5 Aug 1861. The 1<sup>st</sup> Maine Veteran Infantry was formed on 20 Sep 1864 by the consolidation of the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Maine Infantry Regiments.
