# COMBAT INFANTRYMAN BADGE (CIB)

The Combat Infantryman Badge was originally authorized in 1943 for "infantrymen, including officers". By May 1944 the eligibility became more exact: officers and enlisted men of infantry regiments and lower infantry units. <u>Army Regulations 600-70</u> (24 Sep 1951) included men of ranger infantry companies and also officers who, although not of the infantry branch, commanded an infantry unit of regimental or smaller size for at least 30 days. Change 19 of <u>AR 672-5-1</u>, dated 20 Jun 1969, further clarified officer eligibility-he must be in the grade of colonel or below. Change 19 also defined eligible categories of Vietnam service.
