WORLD WAR II-General Sources

**Note:** In general, all males 18 through 64 registered with Selective Service, but liability for call-up to actual military service varied during the war, chiefly consisting of the 18-38 age group. Actual induction of individuals in the liable age groups depended upon physical and mental standards determined by the armed forces. The educational requirement set by the War Dept in 1941 was the fourth grade level, plus literacy in the English language. However, a limited number of less qualified persons were accepted.
