## COMBAT COMMANDERS TABS

Distinctive identification for Army combat leaders originated in the European Theater of Operations, 1944. Dept of Army authorized the familiar green identification bands for qualified warrant officers and enlisted personnel at least as early as 1948, and 2 years later included qualified officers. See:
