

KHE SANH, 1967-68

A Working Bibliography of MHI Sources

Khe Sanh, a border post established in 1962, served USA Special Forces detachments for intelligence gathering operations. US Marines replaced Army units by Jan 1967, with elements of 3rd Marine Regiment garrisoning the expanded base during first half 1967. From Jan to Apr 1968, during its most noted period, the 26th Marine Regiment defended it. See:
